

LOCAL RULES

OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 18.2)

- Beyond the boundary fence on the 1st hole,
- Is defined by the line between the course-side points of white stakes, including those inside the ELECTRIC FENCE to the left of the 8th and 13th holes.

PENALTY AREAS (Rule 17) are marked with red stakes.

On holes 5, 17 and 18, penalty areas marked with red stakes with green tops are NO PLAY ZONES. Entry is strictly FORBIDDEN.

DROPPING ZONES 5th and 18th HOLES: These may be used as an extra option for penalty relief under R17.1d when it is known or virtually certain the ball is in the No Play Zone Penalty area.

ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS (Rule 16.1) Free relief is available for:

- GROUND UNDER REPAIR which is defined by a notice, or any area encircled by a white painted line.
 - IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS such as artificially surfaced cart paths and signs.
 - PROTECTION OF GARDENS AND YOUNG TREES (Rule 16.1F)
- Trees that are staked/supported, as well as gardens, are NO PLAY ZONES. If interference exists with the lie of the ball, stance or intended swing of the player by a staked/supported tree and its bowl, or a garden, the player MUST take free relief under Rule 16.1F. If a ball is known, or virtually certain, to be in a garden but cannot be found, the free relief procedure may be applied using the point at which the ball was seen to enter the garden.
- DROPPING ZONES 4TH HOLE:** As an extra option for relief for a ball that has ended on the path or garden around the green, the player may use the nearest drop zone to where the ball lies.

Note: When gardens and artificially surfaced cart paths are adjacent, they may be treated as a single abnormal course condition when taking relief under R16.1.

POWER LINES (Model Local Rule E-11) If it is known or virtually certain that a player's ball has hit a power line or any structure supporting a power line, the stroke does not count. You MUST replay the shot without penalty from where the previous stroke was made.

BREACH OF A LOCAL RULE: GENERAL PENALTY

REGULATIONS

- Carts must remain on designated paved paths.
- Players must carry a sand/soil bag or bottle and a pitch repair marker.
- Players must fill their divots on the teeing areas (soil boxes provided on all tees) and fairways.
- Please repair your pitch marks on the greens.
- Please do not discard your cigarette butts in the sand boxes or bunkers. Use a dustbin.
- The yellow Srixon practice balls may not be used on the putting park nor anywhere on the golf course. They may be used on the practice chipping green.
